Results

A8+ Qualified with a time of 5:00.8 but lost to Kings College London by 2 lengths

A4+ Qualified 5th with a time of 5:24.8. Beat Durham university in the first round but lost to Manchester by 1¼ lengths

E2- Straight quarterfinal race beaten by Cambridge University by 1¾ lengths

S2x Qualified with a time of 5:36.3. Beaten by Reading

E.lt2x (composite with Edinburgh University) Beat Winnipeg CAN easily. Then beat Wallingford RC (B) by 3½ lengths but was beaten in the final by Wallingford RC (A)
